

CHED REGIONAL MEMORANDUM ORDER No. 15, s. 2022

ONLINE ORIENTATION-SEMINAR ON THEESTABLISHMENT AND ACCREDITATION OF INSTITUTIONAL RESEARCH ETHICS COMMITTEE (REC)

FOR: All Presidents/ Heads

Public and Private Higher Education Institutions (HEIs)

Region 1

1. This Office has issued **CRMO No. 02, s. 2019** on February 28, 2019, reiterating the following memoranda/Administrative Orders:

- a. CHED Memorandum dated March 30, 2015 encouraging all concerned institutions to support and participate in the establishment of RECs and apply for accreditation with the Philippine Health Research Ethics Board (PHREB); and,
- b. CHED, DOH, DOST and UP Manila Joint Memorandum Order No. 2012-001 requiring all concerned institutions to have their researches involving human participants undergo ethical review and clearance before implementation.
- 2. The Regional Development Council I (RDC I) has issued RDC I Resolution No. 61, series of 2019, "Enjoining All Higher Education Institutions, Hospitals, Government Agencies Involved in Conducting Researches to Establish their Research Ethics Committees (RECs and Apply for Accreditation REMB I".
- 3. Article VI Sec. 14 item # 4 of CMO No. 15, s. 2019, also known as "Policies, Standards and Guidelines for Graduate Programs", states that:

 Ethical Standards:

"The HEI maintains ethical standards to be observed by the faculty and students when they conduct research/thesis/dissertation involving human participation or using animal subjects.

Furthermore, the HEI has its own research ethics review mechanism or may partners with a recognized ethics review board..."

- 4. In this regard, an Online Orientation-Seminar on the Establishment and Accreditation of Research Ethics Committee (REC) will be conducted on June 16, 2022 from 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM with the aim of capacitating our HEIs in establishing and subjecting their REC to PHREB accreditation
- 5. Each HEI is given five (5) slots as participants to the said event, preferably the Vice President/Director for Research, REC members and faculty researchers.
