

 - Secure indorsement letter from the President or Head of the higher education institution.

Note: Theses, dissertations and technical reports do not qualify.

- Registration is free. Due to limited slots, only fifteen (15) participants will be accommodated.
 Hence, all documents submitted will be evaluated based on the above-mentioned qualifications.
- You may send your articles and indorsement letter from the President/Head of the institution at ched.gov.ph on or before June 30, 2022, for review and evaluation. Selected participants will be notified as soon as the selection process has been done.
