PARTICIPATION IN THE SEARCH FOR THE BEST ANTI-ILLEGAL DRUG AND CRIME PREVENTION STRATEGIES AND INITIATIVES FOR SY 2022-2023

- 1) As part of our strong commitment to the promotion of a drug and crime-free academic community, this Office will spearhead the Search for The Best Anti-Illegal Drug and Crime Prevention Strategies and Initiatives for SY 2022-2023. This is in line with the KaPADyak Project dubbed as "Kabataan, Kapulisan at Pamantasan nagkakaisa sa Paglaban sa Illegal na Droga at Krimen".
- The objective of the search is to showcase the best practices and accomplishments of higher education institutions with regard to Anti-Illegal Drug and Crime Prevention Strategies and Initiatives for the School Year 2022-2023.

 - c) CHED Memorandum Order No. 42, series of 2005 or The Implementing Guidelines for the Creation of the Student Crime Prevention Councils in all Colleges and Universities;
 - d) CHED Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 18, series of 2018 or The Implementing Guidelines for the Conduct of Drug Testing of Students in all Higher Education Institutions; and
 - e) Executive Order (E) No. 66, series of 2018, or the Institutionalizing the implementation of the Philippine Anti-Illegal Drugs Strategy or PADS.
- 8) The active participation of all Higher Education Institutions in Region 1 is desired.

 - e. Accomplishment reports
 - f. 5-minute video summary of the accomplishment reports
