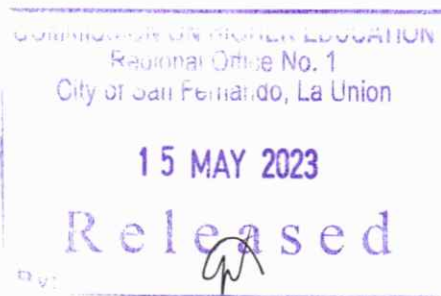

### **PARTICIPATION IN THE SEARCH FOR THE BEST ANTI-ILLEGAL DRUG AND CRIME PREVENTION STRATEGIES AND INITIATIVES FOR SY 2022-2023**

- 1) As part of our strong commitment to the promotion of a drug and crime-free academic community, this Office will spearhead the Search for The Best Anti-Illegal Drug and Crime Prevention Strategies and Initiatives for SY 2022-2023.   - b) Section 28.5 of the CHED Memorandum Order No. 09, series of 2013 or the "Enhanced Policies and Guidelines on Student Affairs and Services,
  - c) CHED Memorandum Order No. 42, series of 2005 or The Implementing Guidelines for the Creation of the Student Crime Prevention Councils in all Colleges and Universities;
  - d) CHED Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 18, series of 2018 or The Implementing Guidelines for the Conduct of Drug Testing of Students in all Higher Education Institutions; and
  - e) Executive Order (E) No. 66, series of 2018, or the Institutionalizing the implementation of the Philippine Anti-Illegal Drugs Strategy or PADS.
- 8) The active participation of all Higher Education Institutions in Region 1 is desired.

  - a. Endorsement of the HEI President
  - b. Cover Page (preferably poster-type) – the name of SC organization and HEI
  - c. Name and Brief Description of the Projects/Programs
  - d. Rationale and Objectives
  - e. Accomplishment reports
  - f. 5-minute video summary of the accomplishment reports
3. Entries shall be in pdf format:
  - a. bond paper size: Folio (8.5"x13")
  - b. font-size: 12
  - c. font type: Arial
  - d. margin: 1" all sides
  - e. file name: KAPADYAK\_name of your school\_name of your organization
4. Projects will be judged according to the criteria.
