  - c. Date and Venue
  - d. Club and Individual Proponents
  - e. Beneficiaries
  - f. Partners (if there were any)
  - g. Rationale that includes the Objectives
  - h. Budgetary Requirements
  - i. Activities
  - Documentations such as pictures or videos.
  - k. Insights from the beneficiaries/proponents/partners
- Entries shall be in pdf format:
  - a. bond paper size :A4
  - b. font size: 12
  - c. font type: Arial
  - d. margin: 1" all sides
  - e. file name: E-VAW-PEA\_name of your school\_name of your organization
- 5. Projects will be judged according to:

Relevance 40% Impact and Sustainability 20% Creativity and Resourcefulness 20% Report 20%
