PROJECT PROPOSAL

PROJECT TITLE: 2023 NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

THEME: "WE for gender equality and inclusive society"

RESPONSIBLE AGENCY: Commission on Higher Education Region 1

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

Per PCW Memorandum Circular No. 2023 – 01 or the Guide for the 2023 National Women's Month Celebration (2022 NWMC), the celebration is in recognition of women's role and contribution in nation-building and as agents of national development. This celebration also coincides with the worldwide observance of the International Women's Day (IWD).

This 2023, the PCW launches a new recurring theme for the celebration: WE for gender equality and inclusive society, along with the official hashtag #WEcanbeEquAll. The 2023-2028 theme is both a positive affirmation and a call to action. It is a testament to the milestones achieved in closing gender gaps in the country and in gathering more support to the advocacy. Notably, the Philippines remains the best-performing country in Asia in terms of gender parity, according to the 2022 Global Gender Gap Report of the World Economic Forum. In a scale of 0 to 1, where 1 represents optimal gender parity, the country scored 0.783, a slight slip from the 2022 score of 0.784. This means that the Philippines still has a 21.7% gender gap to close. While the Report shows that the country dropped from the 17th to 19th spot in the general ranking out of 146 countries, the Philippines is still at the second place in the whole of East Asia and the Pacific, next to New Zealand. Moreover, the country is still leading among its Asia counterparts, being the only Asian country in the top twenty, with Singapore and Lao PDR ranking 49th and 53rd, respectively. Hence, the campaign shows the urgency to strengthen efforts toward gender equality and women's empowerment (GEWE).

As one of the responsible agencies in educating the students of higher learning, CHED ROI actively participates in the National Women's Month Celebration. We believe that the key in closing the gender gaps is to intensify the involvement of the higher education sector through capacity building, technology, innovation and system implementation.

OBJECTIVES:

- To inform and engage women and everyone to push for gender-responsive programs and services in the higher education institutions (HEIs) that empower women to contribute to nation-building;
- 2. To provide platforms to share good practices and address gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing gender and development (GAD) in the sector of higher education;
- 3. To capacitate the GAD Focal Persons of higher education institutions (HEIs) in the region relative to the CMO on GAD and its Monitoring and Evaluation System (GEMS);
- 4. To inspire women and girls to empower themselves and take on leadership roles, especially in the fields of research and innovation, to maximize their full potential and enable them to reap the fruits of gender equality;
- 5. To honor our women in their roles and contributions to the society through the provisions of priority lanes in the agency's frontline services, IEC materials and freebies.
