CHED ROI conducts monitoring visit at UCC

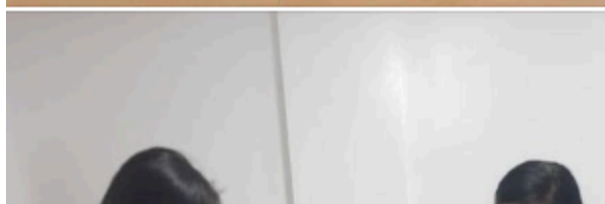

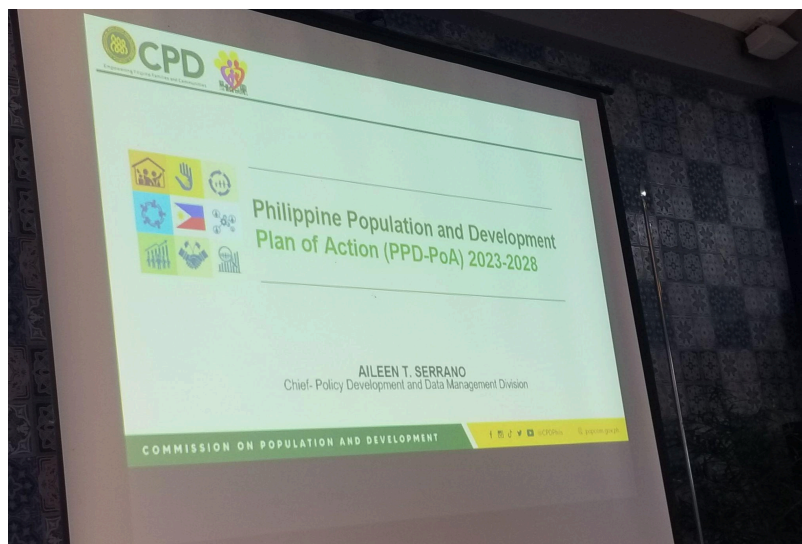
